WED is an opportunity to celebrate engineering and the contribution of our Electronics Engineers for a better, sustainable world. IECEP Inc., being a member organization of the Philippine Technological Council (PTC) - which is the Philippine National Member of WFEO, is one with PTC and WFEO in the celebration of WED in the Philippines and worldwide.

As such, all Chapters and Societies are hereby enjoined to organize an event within their locality that will exhibit support in celebration of the event on its opening festivities this March 4, 2023. Chapters are enjoined to organize Fun Run or Tree Planting Activities which will be in sync with the PTC Opening Activities worldwide.
