SUBJECT: IECEP HOME | NATIONAL OFFICE ADMISSION GUIDELINES

DATE **05 JULY 2023**

Admission to the National Office or what we simply call as IECEP Home, headquartered at 52A P. Gomez St., Brgy. Poblacion, Mandaluyong City, shall be reserved ONLY for those with official business with the Institute. In consideration of engagements conducted at IECEP Home facilities, and other internal office administration activities, which may involve processing personal, sensitive personal and other privileged information, the Secretary General or the duly designated representative of the National Office is hereby given prerogative to approve / disapprove entry, as well as to

order dismissal of admitted individuals.

In view of the official business hours of the National Office, members are likewise advised to conduct their transactions between 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM only. As IECEP now employs DIGITAL OPTIONS for membership-related services, ONLINE TRANSACTIONS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED for the General Membership. With this, WALK-INS may be admitted on a case-to-case basis. All visitors are hereby further advised that CCTV Operations are in place within the vicinity and inside IECEP Home; hence, consent is secured with the act of signing in the Visitors' Log.

It is hereby clarified that under no circumstances shall members be admitted to the Office Room/s of the National Secretariat adjacent to the Executive Board Room nor to the Executive Board Room itself unless prior OFFICIAL WRITTEN approval from the Secretary General has been secured, considering the systems and applications in place.

These guidelines do not cover THIRD-PARTY SERVICE PROVIDERS such as COURIER SERVICES / DELIVERIES, as they are not admitted in IECEP Home. Receiving of packages shall be done EXCLUSIVELY OUTSIDE THE NATIONAL OFFICE, as may be visible on the CCTV.

This policy is hereby promulgated to strengthen the security procedures implemented in the National Office, and to preserve the routine office operations of IECEP Home. The National Secretariat, the National Secretary General and the Property Management and Office Administration Committee (PMOAC), as well as concerned Officials, are empowered to implement this Order. A Scheduler Application may soon be also implemented, based on the recommendation of the Property Management and
