Please be apprised that IECEP Inc shall collect pertinent information for the processing of payments for rendition of services, delivery of goods and other related contracts. Concerned stakeholders shall nominate a bank account or a mobile wallet.

Enrollment to IECEP Inc's vendor platform for disbursements shall be accomplished for the successful facilitation of payments.

In line with this, all concerned are advised that IECEP Inc shall only process payments every 25th of the month, through our digital payments platform; payments processed are expected to be remitted to respective accounts within 2-3 working days.

Notwithstanding subsisting contracts, the National Support Secretariat via iecep.nationaloffice@gmail.com shall coordinate with respective focals to effect this adjustment on payment schedule.

All concerned are requested to monitor incoming remittances and encouraged to coordinate with the National Supervising Secretariat for Finance via iecep.finance@gmail.com for any arising concerns.

With this, issuance of checks for settlement of payment obligations shall be discontinued in principle. Written requests for immediate payments in the form of checks for pick-up shall be levied minimal administrative fees and shall be subject for approval of the National Treasurer.
